There are endless tours around New Orleans. Here is a list of some tours. The first few are close to the Doubletree in Kenner.



1. Destrehan Plantation- 13034 River Road, Destrehan, LA 70047 985-764- 9315, destrehanplantation.org. Just a few miles from Kenner via I-10 and I-310 on River Road. Costumed tour guides give a tour depicting the 1811 slave revolt, family, and documents. A mile further is Ormond Plantation Restaurant where you can dine in the

plantation.

2. Longue Vue House and Gardens- 7 Bamboo Rd. New Orleans, LA 70124 504-488-5488, longuevue.com (Off Metairie Rd. in Old Metairie) Longue Vue features a fascinating historic home and 15 beautiful gardens.

3. Cajun Pride Swamp Tours- 110 Frenier Rd. LaPlace, LA 70068 504-467-0758, cajunprideswamps.com Visit us in the Manchac Swamp on our privately-owned wildlife refuge. They also offer combination plantation tours. (Just off I-10 at LaPlace exit.)
