What a beautiful city with so many attractions and our Minnesota sisters made everyone feel welcome.

So many wonderful things to report on that involved our Louisiana sisters. You will find a complete report on Terry's web page. Here are a few of the highlights for the biennium.

Altruistic Report:

Total Hours - 2,064,208; Total --\$8,495,740; Total Other Monetary --\$5,296,378; Total Scholarship--\$2,026,455. GRAND TOTAL - \$15,818,643

World Understanding:

Speaker Melissa Young, Imagine Missions with project TEACH, TOO received an additional \$42,000+

Membership Report:

Gained 3,000+ new members during the new biennium, LOST - 5000 members (Omega, disbanded, relocated resignation) Net - 2000. Highlight - 4 new chapters chartered and 1 new collegiate chapter.

Foundation Report:

\$250,000 awarded per year in grants/scholarships

International Altruistic Projects:

St. Jude's and Alzheimer's Association --\$70,000 to each during the biennium
2018 Walk --\$27,000 and 2019 Longest Day --\$99,150.

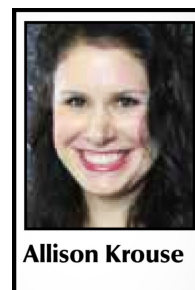

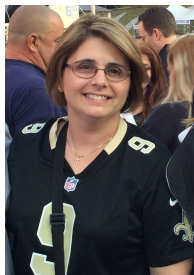
